Food Preparation and Kitchen Areas

- U U □ Food preparation surfaces & countertops
 - ☐ Food contact surfaces (plates, utensils, pots, etc.)
 - Refrigerator/freezer
 - ☐ Stove, oven, grill, ventilation/exhaust hood
- ☐ Microwave, food warmers, buffet line equipment etc.
- ☐ Tables, Chairs & Highchair trays
- ☐ Food Waste Receptables
- □ Ice machine



Washrooms/Toilet and Diapering Areas

- ☐ Diaper changing table mat
- ☐ Stand-alone potty chairs
- ☐ Handwashing sinks & faucets
- ☐ Countertops, Child toilet adapters

- ☐ Toilets (floors and fixtures)
- ☐ Diaper waste receptacles
- ☐ Floors



Play and Activity Areas

- Pacifiers (designated by child's name only)
- ☐ Plastic mouthed toys and teething rings (all ages)
- Wooden toys,
- Toys (<3yr olds)</p>

- ☐ Toys (3-5 years)
- ☐ Toys cardboard and/or fiberboard
- ☐ Large toys (e.g., Play activity centers)



Office and Administration Areas

- ☐ Computer keyboards/mouse
- ipads/tablets
- Office furniture and fixtures





High Touch Surface Areas

- ☐ High-touch surfaces (door handles, light switches)
- Drinking fountains
- Uncarpeted Floors

- ☐ Carpets & large area rugs
- ☐ Infant & general purpose activity floor mats
- ☐ Vertical mats (e.g. fitness room)



Crib and Bed Areas

- ☐ Bedding: Bed sheets, pillow cases, blankets
- ☐ Fabric mattress pads/covers
- □ Cribs, portable cribs, and cots

- ☐ Impervious surface of Mattresses, mattress covers, &
- □ sleeping mats
